Voluntary Assessment Fee/Request for ODAFF to Prepare NMP/AWMP

I am voluntarily requesting the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (Department) to write a Nutrient Management Plan (NMP)/Animal Waste Management Plan (AWMP) for my registered poultry feeding operation.

Pursuant to Title 35:17-5-3, I agree to the annual assessment of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the purpose of securing the Departments service of drafting a NMP/AWMP for my registered poultry feeding operation. The plan is good for 6-years unless revisions/modifications are needed. I understand that the Department will not prepare a NMP/AWMP until the full \$600 voluntary fee has been received (equivalent to \$100/year).

I have recently collected samples of soil and poultry waste and submitted them to a laboratory for analysis. I understand that the Department will contact me for more information, including lab results that will be used in writing a plan.
