1-11-19**

Receipts: 5,549 Last Week 3,190 Last Year 3,342

Alfalfa trade was very slow this week. Movement was light to moderate. Dairy demand was light while demand from feedlots and other beef producers was moderate. Alfalfa movement into the state from out of state sources was moderate. Grass hay demand was fairly good for good quality Bermuda, wheat hay and native grass hay. Limited supplies and offerings of this type hay were noted. Recent rains and snow have left much of the state saturated and have ended any drought designations.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers were to lightly tested last week on a Current FOB basis for a true market test. Receipts this week consisted of 100 percent over 600 lbs and 27 percent heifers. Unless otherwise 3 stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.

Alfalfa

Central Oklahoma: Premium quality 200.00-220.00. Good quality large square and large round bales 180.00-200.00. Fair quality 140.00-160.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Fair to Good quality large round bales delivered 205.00-240.00.

Western Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 200.00-220.00, instances to 225.00. Good quality large round and large square bales 180.00-200.00. Grinding hay 140.00-150.00.

Grass Hay

Central Oklahoma: Good quality Bermuda grass in 4 X 6 through 5 X 6 bales mostly 55.00-70.00 per bale. Few in 4 X 5 1/2 bales 50.00. Good quality mixed grass hay 5 X 5 and 5 X 6 bales 50.00-60.00 per bale. Mixed grass 90.00-100.00 per ton.

Western Oklahoma: Good quality mixed grass round bales 90.00-110.00 per ton. Mixed grass 5 X 5 1/2 to 5 X 6 bales 50.00-70.00 per bale. Good quality wheat hay 5 X 6 bales 55.00 per bale.
