Alfalfa trade was slow to moderate this week. Movement mostly moderate. Dairy demand was mostly light. Demand from feedlots and other beef producers was moderate to good. Alfalfa movement into the state from out of state sources was moderate to active. Grass hay demand was fairly good for good quality Bermuda, wheat hay and native grass hay. Buyers were actively seeking supplies of these offerings. Wet, muddy conditions persist and another round of winter weather is expected this weekend.
