OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT

5-23-19

Alfalfa trade and movement remains very light as rain and storms continue to impede haying activities. Demand was moderate to good for first cutting alfalfa. A large percentage of first cutting offerings are rain damaged, over mature or both. A good amount of wheat hay may still be put up but the window for best quality wheat hay is over. Too few sales confirmed this week for a full market but overall steady undertone noted. Oklahoma entered this haying season with the lowest hay stocks on hand since 2012, according to USDA National Agricultural Statistics Service.
