**Oklahoma Direct Feeder Cattle Trade
6-08-18**

Alfalfa trade was light to moderate. Demand also only moderate this week even though offerings appear fairly light. Movement was mostly light to moderate. First cutting is wrapping up with yields being reported mostly much lower than average on dryland acres. Overall quality was reported to be mostly very good. Drought is still very much a concern for much of western and central Oklahoma with NASS reporting 30 percent of the state in extreme drought and 10 percent in exceptional drought.

Receipts: 1,106 Last Week 4,898 Last Year 6,277

Compared to last week: Not enough Current FOB trades to establish a market test, however a higher undertone is noted. Receipts this week consisted of 100 percent over 600 lbs and 15 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.

Central Oklahoma: In light test prices steady to 10.00 higher. Supreme quality large square bales 200.00. Premium quality 180.00-190.00. Good quality large square and large round bales 150.00-165.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: No sales confirmed.
