**OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT
7-12-18**

Alfalfa trade was light to mostly moderate. Demand moderate to good on mostly moderate offerings. Prices were fully steady. Demand from dairies remains light to moderate at best. Some growers are choosing to hold on to the better quality alfalfa for later sale. USDA NASS estimated the third cutting of alfalfa was 25 percent completed as of last week with second cutting 85 percent complete. Drought conditions improved slightly but 27 percent of the state remains under extreme to exceptional drought condition.

Alfalfa

Central Oklahoma: Premium quality 180.00-200.00, mostly 190.00. Good quality large square and large round bales 160.00-170.00.

Eastern Oklahoma: Premium quality 180.00-190.00 per ton. Few local sales small square bales 12.00-14.00 per bale.

Western Oklahoma: Premium quality large square bales 180.00-190.00. Good quality bunk hay 150.00-165.00. Fair quality large round bales 140.00-150.00.

Grass Hay

Central Oklahoma: Good quality mixed grass hay 4 X 5 bales 35.00-45.00 per bale, Fair quality 30.00-35.00 per bale. Wheat hay in round and large square bales 90.00-120.00 per ton, mostly 100.00-110.00 per ton. Mixed grass 80.00-100.00 per ton.
