Receipts: 9,607 Last Week 3,905 Last Year 5,140

Hay trade has slowed down across much of the state. Cooler than Average weather has swept across the trade area bringing much wanted relief from last week's triple digits temps. Prices were mostly steady, movement has slowed down. Heavy supply of alfalfa suitable for feed yards is readily available causing a lower demand from buyers. Surprisingly, demand is extremely light. High temperatures have made for lush pastures, however moisture is needed.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers mostly steady on limited comparable sales. Demand moderate. Very dry conditions continue across the trade area. Supply consisted of 97 percent over 600 lbs and 63 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
