Alfalfa and hay movement very limited last week. Not enough trades last week for an accurate market trend. Demand for hay and alfalfa continues to be good for dairies and all classes. Scattered thunderstorms and rain are making their way across the state late this week and expected throughout the weekend.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers traded 2.00-4.00 higher coming off of last week's sharply lower market. Demand moderate to good. Supply consisted of 95 percent over 600 lbs and 88 percent heifers. Unless otherwise stated prices are FOB weigh point with a 2-3 percent shrink or equivalent and with a 8-12 cent slide on calves and 4-8 cent slide on yearlings from base weights. Current sales up to 14 days for delivery.
