OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT

8-30-18

Alfalfa trade moderate to fairly active this week. Demand was very good for all offerings. Movement was fairly active. Prices steady to firm. Supplies and offerings lighter this week even though third cutting is wrapping up and fourth cutting well underway. Grass hay baling activities also remain active in central and eastern counties. Grass hay demand is good and trading mostly moderate. Dry, hot and windy conditions were the rule this week and drought conditions remain moderate to exceptional over 32 percent of the state with 6 percent still in severe to exceptional drought.
