Hay trade has been sluggish as producers hoping a higher feed price would encourage more hay feeding, however feed prices have held relatively low, thus hurting the demand for hay. Another item that has limited the hay trade has been those who will bale whatever Mother Nature has in the field. Producers have been busy working ground and or planting both wheat and hay ahead of a forecasted rain and cold front headed thru the state today. Haying should pick up if this rain does fall.
