

How to Register Your Environmentally Sensitive Crop

Registering your environmentally sensitive field will help to notify Commercial and Private Pesticide Applicators to the location of your fields and crops using GPS coordinates and help prevent drift damage.

Registration and use of this system is free.



Step 5: If you do not know your GPS coordinates click the link "Use Interactive Map to Plot GPS Coordinates"


1. Plot your fields location by zooming in on the state map using the + and – signs in the upper right corner of the map.



2. You can also zoom in by hovering your mouse arrow over an area of the map and using the toggle wheel to zoom in or out on the map.



3. If you need to move the map left click and hold the mouse button to drag the map to a different location. .



- Once you have found your field location, Click on the appropriate location and your GPS coordinates will be saved. The coordinates they will automatically be added to the previous page.
