Moisture has helped crop production in Western Oklahoma but unfortunately, it has also, slowed or stopped the wheat production and continues to hinder parts of the east by continuing to receive too much rain in a short amount of time. Due to the having so much rain it has also slowed or stopped production in the east. Positive note the rain has allowed most of the central and all of eastern Oklahoma to be out of the drought conditions. Western Oklahoma is still in need of rain to help release themselves out of the drought conditions which are still in extreme to exceptional drought conditions.
