Compared to the last report: The hay trade is slow to steady. As we look at the market trend we still haven't fully begun to discover a true market trend for all types of hay. We are seeing that the rain has slowed down along with the sun to dry out the moisture. Which has allowed the farmers to start laying down and baling hay. The Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor tells us that all of the central and eastern parts of Oklahoma are no longer in drought conditions. Most of the west is in moderate to abnormally dry conditions. Yet, there are still parts in the upper northwest and the Oklahoma panhandle with extreme to exceptional drought.
