Hay prices rise once more as the supply goes down, yet hay demand continues. We did see some rainfall across the state but most fell in the eastern part of Oklahoma. As we look at the Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor we are currently at 8.86 percent in exceptional drought, 36.64 percent in an extreme drought, 53.52 percent in severe drought, 66.88 percent in moderate, 77.15 percent in abnormally dry conditions, 22.85 percent that has no drought conditions.
