2024 ODAFF Hemp Processor/Handler License Application

<u>Checklist</u>

- □ Must be submitted at least 30 days before you begin processing/handling
- All Hemp Processor/Handler Licenses expire on December 31 of the year they are earned
- □ A criminal history report for each key participant dated within sixty (60) days prior to the application submission date
- Provide proof of ownership for processing/handling area OR provide a lease for the property in which the property owner grants permission to the processor/handler to process/handle hemp on their property-must provide proof of ownership as well
- □ Must submit a separate application for each processing/handling facility
- You must include either a map or a blueprint of the building-include the total square feet of the processing building
- Each key participant will sign their own Acknowledgement and Agreement Page
- Complete all pages of the application and submit all required information-incomplete applications cannot be processed
- □ All fees submitted to ODAFF are nonrefundable

Important Definitions:

Handling: possessing or storing industrial hemp for any period of time on premises owned, operated, or controlled by a person licensed to cultivate or process industrial hemp. Handling includes possessing or storing industrial hemp in a vehicle for any period of time other than during its actual transportation from the premises of a licensed person to cultivate or process industrial hemp to the premises of another licensed person.

Key Participant: means a person or persons who have a direct or indirect financial interest in an entity producing hemp, such as an owner or a partner in a partnership. Executive level corporate employees, including chief executive officer, chief operating officer, and chief financial officer shall be considered Key Participants. Management level positions such as farm, field, and shift managers shall not be considered Key Participants.

Processing: means converting industrial hemp into a marketable form, including the production of all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers.

_____The processor/handler licensee shall fully cooperate with the ODAFF, grant the ODAFF physical access to any part of the processing/handling site and allow the ODAFF to conduct inspection and sampling

_____The processor/handler licensee shall submit all required reports by the dates specified by the ODAFF.

_____The processor/handler licensee shall follow the law and rules of the Oklahoma Industrial Hemp Program

_____The processor/handler licensee shall retain the following records for three (3) years from the date the record is obtained or generated:

- (1) License number of the grower;
- (2) Copy of the Certificate of Analysis; and
- (3) Amount of hemp purchased from grower.
