2. Education

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All Poultry Waste Applicators must continue to maintain required education as outlined in Title 2 Section 10-9.5(F)(1) In summary:

- New Applicators must complete the OSU Extension I-9 Course within the first year of certification
- Following first year, applicators must complete 2 hours per year for 5 consecutive years for a total of 10 hours
- After the first 6 years (19 hours), applicators must complete 2 hours for every 3-year cycle

The Department refers to the OSU Extension Office for verification of attendance for all training hours.
