# OKLAHOMA HAY MARKET REPORT

5-24-24

Receipts: 3,525 Last Reported: 2,130 Year Ago:550

Compared to the last report: We have had several storms across Oklahoma which have slowed down some hay trade as well as hay baling. Wheat hay movement has picked up but not enough to say the demand is high. Old-crop hay continues to move lower in price as we enter the new hay season. We still have barns full of old-crop hay that are trying to be sold and emptied for new-crop hay. Wheat harvest has started in parts of Oklahoma. The rest of Oklahoma's wheat harvest will begin in the coming weeks, which might slow down more trade.
