Western Oklahoma is still seeing allocation of Nitrogen based fertilizers. Eastern Oklahoma saw supply disruptions last week because of flooding of the Arkansas River but no allocation of fertilizers at this time. Heavy rain is forecasted for much of Oklahoma and more flooding in Eastern Oklahoma is likely. Domestic Potash prices are likely to remain steady after price increases in the last two weeks. Most Potash is imported and international Potash will see price increases in the future. Triple 19 fertilizer was added to this report. Farm diesel and propane prices increased slightly.
