Compared to last report: Volatility in Just-In-Time pricing define this report. Urea shows a slight uptick in price, current spot prices are down \$60-\$80 per ton compared to last week. In contrast DAP prices have surged significantly. As retailers exhaust their existing contracted supply, expect sharp price increases in the coming months. UAN prices have stabilized, but not because demand has dropped, it's because supply is essentially locked up. Most UAN was contacted earlier this spring, and current supply is extremely limited in Western Oklahoma and unavailable in Eastern Oklahoma at the retail level. With corn planting nearly complete across Oklahoma, side-dress season is here but many growers may find UAN hard to source if they didn't secure it ahead of time. Farm diesel and propane remain unchanged.
