Compared to last report: Volatility in the fertilizer market is starting to level out. Urea prices remained elevated but appear to be stabilizing which may offer some relief to producers planning for late-season nitrogen applications. DAP has seen slight uptick in price and the industry still has concerns of supply issues. The Iranian parliament voted to close the Strait of Hormuz, raising serious concerns across the global fertilizer industry. More than 50% of the world's nitrogen fertilizer move through this vital shipping corridor. With this development industry leaders are closely watching how it may impact fertilizer contracts for this fall. While no physical disruption has occurred, the threat alone is creating uncertainty in fall supply planning. Farm diesel prices have seen a recent spike, driven in part by rising crude oil futures and global shipping concerns. Meanwhile, hot conditions across Oklahoma have reduced the need for propane, easing prices.
