Compared to last report: Anhydrous and blended fertilizers saw mixed pricing this report. DAP and MAP prices continue their upward trend due to resource constraints and import policies. Potash was slightly higher, though ongoing tariffs continue to pressure the cost of imported product. Urea, while still down from its peak a month ago, jumped \$25/ton this week in Just-In-Time inventory, as high water levels at the port have delayed barge offloading. In Eastern Oklahoma, retailers are once again stocked with liquid nitrogen; however, new contracts are priced significantly higher than those secured earlier in the spring. Farm diesel and propane were unchanged.
