Compared to last report: This report was mixed, with nitrogen based fertilizers moving lower while phosphorus based products pushed higher. We are now seeing a market anomaly, as the global UAN market faces persistent supply issues, yet prices continue to decline. Phosphorus based fertilizer prices flattened in the last report but have since resumed their upward climb. UAN and Urea prices continue to decline, while DAP and MAP prices keep rising; however, we may see a convergence as both fertilizer groups face similar pressures: prolonged supply issues, the prospect of additional tariffs on Russia and China, and expectations of strong demand. Such pressures may drive prices across the board upward in 2026. Industry experts who had predicted a 4% decline in nitrogen based fertilizers, for 2026, may be revising their outlook. Farm diesel prices were slightly higher. Propane prices fell as several companies introduced special fall promotions for the coming weeks.

Compared to last report: Feed prices unchanged for this report. The October 2025 feed report will mark the start of winter feed pricing. Prices will begin to adjust for the winter feeding months. Corn harvesting is underway in Oklahoma, and yield estimates are up 32 bushel at 130 bushels per acre. Wheat planting is underway in Oklahoma, with timely rains providing ideal conditions. An abundant wheat grazing crop is expected across the state for the winter months. Cattle prices have recently come under pressure due to declining boxed beef values, packers reducing bids on fats, and weakening calf health.
