The Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor shows that 0 percent of the state is in exceptional drought, 4.80 percent is in extreme drought, 13.95 percent is in severe drought, 53.74 percent is moderate, 79.13 percent is abnormally dry conditions, and 20.87 percent has no drought conditions.
