Compared to the last report. Movement is at a standstill to steady. Drought worsens; 68 percent of the state has some form of drought. We do not see any cold weather or moisture in the future. Christmas and New Year's are a few days away, and movement might slow down even more.

Trends: No Trends currently.

The Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor shows that 0 percent of the state is in exceptional drought, 3.48 percent is in extreme drought, 11.11 percent is in severe drought, 32.11 percent is moderate, 59.20 percent is abnormally dry conditions, and 40.80 percent has no drought conditions.

Compared to last report: New feed contacts have been added to this feed report, contributing to the inconsistent feed prices. CME feeder cattle futures have posted strong gains throughout the month. Auction prices continue to rebound with feeder cattle trading as much as 15.00 higher and calves 10.00-20.00 higher with instances of up to 40.00 higher. Wheat pasture conditions across Oklahoma look good, though a rain would be beneficial. After Sunday, temperatures are forecasted to rise into the 70s by next Friday, making mid-December feeling more like mid-April.
