



Governor Stitt's Outstanding Achievement in Agriculture Award

Purpose

The Outstanding Achievement in Agriculture Award is the highest award given by the Governor to honor distinguished Oklahoma agriculture contributors. This prestigious award honors leaders in the agriculture industry who exemplify personal values, performance and achievement. Nominees should have high standards of conduct, leadership, innovation, and accomplishments in agriculture and should be a role model for Oklahoma agriculture's young people. Those nominated must be living (no posthumous nominations).

Recognition

The winner of Governor Stitt's Outstanding Achievement in Agriculture Award will be honored on Oklahoma Ag Day at the State Capitol on April 29. The honoree will be inducted into the Agriculture Hall of Fame located at the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, where their portrait and biography will be on display. The award winner will be notified in a timely manner prior to the ceremony.

Applications must include:

A. Application form

B. Contributions to Oklahoma Agriculture Narrative (2 page limit): Governor Stitt's Outstanding Achievement in Agriculture Award is intended to recognize agriculture as an integral part of our society and agriculturalists as contributors to the well-being of Oklahoma. The narrative may cover one or a combination of the following activities as they relate to agriculture in Oklahoma:

- Involvement in agriculture
- Promotion of agriculture
- Time and talents devoted to agriculture
- Leadership roles

This should be limited to 2 pages front and back, 12 point font, double spaced, 1 inch margins.

C. Up to two letters of support: These letters may be from local government officials, other producers, technical consultants, association representatives or others with firsthand knowledge of the nominee's contributions to Oklahoma agriculture. The typed letters should detail the author's involvement with the nominee and his or her knowledge of the producer's significant contributions. Letters should not exceed two (2) pages each and must accompany the application.

Deadline for Submitting Application
