Compared to the last report. Due to the snowstorm, movement has picked up; movement has been slow to steady over the past couple of weeks. We do see continued colder temperatures for next week's forecast. Drought worsens; 82 percent of the state has some form of drought.

The Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor indicates that 0 percent of the state is experiencing exceptional drought, 8.03 percent is in extreme drought, 23.32 percent is in severe drought, 71.69 percent is in moderate drought, 82.62 percent is in abnormally dry conditions, and 17.38 percent has no drought conditions.

Compared to last report: Feed prices have adjusted slightly on commodity types feeds. This winter has been unusually mild but very dry. Some areas of Oklahoma received light rain yesterday, which will provide short-term relief for wheat, though soils are drying out quickly with temperatures remaining well above normal. CME cattle futures have risen since the last report. Demand remains very strong for all classes of cattle with prices reaching near-record levels during the first week of sales this year. While cow-calf producers are benefiting from these cattle prices, tightening supplies and strong demand have many in the industry questioning how much futher prices can climb before stocker producers begin to lose money.
