Oklahoma Production Cost Report (Bi-Weekly)

3-6-26

Compared to last report: The fertilizer and oil markets turned erratic this week as Iran shut down the Strait of Hormuz and warned it will attack any ships attempting to pass through the strait. Nitrogen-based fertilizers were extremely volatile, as Anhydrous and Urea have each gained over \$100 per ton since the last report. As the conflict involving Iran continues, some buyers have shifted sourcing nitrogen away from Iran towards Russia and others producing countries, adding upward pressure to global fertilizer prices. One contact quoted a price for Urea at \$645 a ton at 8:15am on Friday and then called back at 10am and said the Urea quote is now at \$760 a ton, that is a \$220 per ton increase since Monday morning. Another contact couldn't get a quote on Urea from the Port of Catoosa, as offloading of fertilizer has stopped at the port due to price volatility. In Western Oklahoma, three fertilizer manufacturers will start allocation of Urea and UAN tomorrow, leading to speculation of more price increases. Farm diesel is up 25 cents this report. Oil futures have seen a price increase of \$23 a barrel in one week.
