Compared to last report: All 7 major fertilizers saw a slight price adjustment except for Anhydrous which increased in price almost 6%. As fertilizer demand increases with warming weather, the industry remains uncertain whether additional tariffs will be imposed on the importation of fertilizers. Concerns over the use of the Strait of Hormuz are now back at the forefront, as Iran seized two oil tankers on Thursday. The Strait of Hormuz plays a critical role in the global fertilizer industry, with roughly one-third of the world's fertilizer shipments passing through this key waterway. Farm diesel and propane prices begin to rise last week, as colder weather and snow boosted consumption of both products.

**Oklahoma Retail Feed Cost Report (Monthly)**

Compared to last report: Prices adjusted slightly lower on bulk feeds. The most notable point from this feed report is the scarcity of cottonseed meal. Commodity brokers are struggling to locate a source, as cottonseed meal and hulls are now being used to frack oil wells, leaving this commodity in high demand and short supply. One contact secured three loads of cottonseed hulls delivered to South Texas at \$16,000 per load, or approximately \$667 per ton. Oklahoma experienced extreme weather last week, with temperatures dropping below zero in some parts of the state and snowfall totals up to 14 inches. This week is much warmer with highs in the 60s and 70s and Southern Oklahoma is forecasted to reach the 80s on Monday. Drought continues to be a concern, as 94% of Oklahoma is experiencing some sort of drought conditions.
