Oklahoma Production Cost Report (Bi-Weekly)

Compared to last report: Most fertilizers continue to trend higher this report, although some leveling off was noted in urea prices as spot values at the port have declined. Suppliers to Western Oklahoma have also lifted allocation restrictions on nitrogen-based fertilizers, helping ease some immediate supply pressure. Some contacts reported lower urea prices, but liquid nitrogen values continue to trend higher across all contacts. Drought conditions in Western Oklahoma have reduced demand pressure for fertilizers. Farm diesel, once again returned to surging higher, with prices increasing \$2.01 per gallon since the first of the year.

Compared to last report: Feed prices were mixed this report as summer grazing season begins. Cottonseed Mill is once again being sourced out of the Midwest rather than California, contributing to the sharp decline in price. Wheat midds are the other commodity that has seen a significant price decrease, as global supply has continued to outpace demand. While much of Oklahoma received significant rainfall throughout April, extreme drought increased from 25% to 30% across the state. Severe storms persisted across Oklahoma in late April, bringing periods of heavy rainfall, strong winds, and devastating tornadoes. Live cattle traded this morning at 255-257 on a live basis and 400-405 on a dressed basis; this has helped push feeder cattle higher in sale barns across the state.
