Contracts for hay are being placed before harvesting. Even with contracts, prices for new crop grass hay are still to be determined. Drought has increased to 99.61 percent of the state that has some form of drought.

The Oklahoma Mesonet Drought Monitor indicates that 9.21 percent of the state is experiencing exceptional drought, 38.42 percent is in extreme drought, 45.54 percent is in severe drought, 80.76 percent is in moderate drought, 99.31 percent is in abnormally dry conditions, and 0.69 percent has no drought conditions.

Some contacts reported urea under 700 per ton and farm diesel under 4.00 per gallon for the first time in two months. The USDA released its monthly WASDE report this week. The report was largely neutral for corn and soybeans, but lowered winter wheat production estimates as drought conditions in parts of the Plains continue to impact yields. Estimates show the smallest winter wheat crop since the mid 1960s. Welcome rains fell across much of the state in the past two weeks, easing some drought conditions in many areas and helping push the cattle market higher this week.

Negotiated cash trade are in line with the last report a month ago, but remain below the all-time highs of 265 reached a couple of weeks ago. Today's trade ranged from 255 to 258. CME cattle futures traded in the red today, as the market continues to experience significant volatility, with large swings both higher and lower from one day to the next.
