With drought in the Western Cornbelt and flooding in the Eastern Cornbelt, this fall's corn yields remain uncertain. The only thing that remains the same from the last report is the unbearable heat across Oklahoma with no relief in sight on the 10 day forecast. Negotiated cash fed cattle prices continue lower at 223.00-227.00. Input costs are mixed, nitrogen based fertilizer prices continue to ease but farm diesel continues its sharp rise. The feeder cattle and calf markets have once again declined. Since the market highs on the week of June 26th, five-weight steers have declined 81.00 per hundredweight from 5.09 to 4.28 currently and eight-weight steers have fallen 46.00 per hundredweight from 3.84 to 3.38 per pound.
